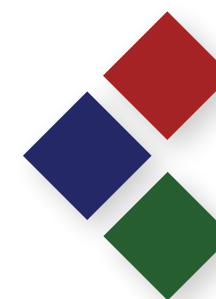

Even in times of economic uncertainty, we each have a deep reserve of generosity, which we can deploy in a variety of ways to make a difference

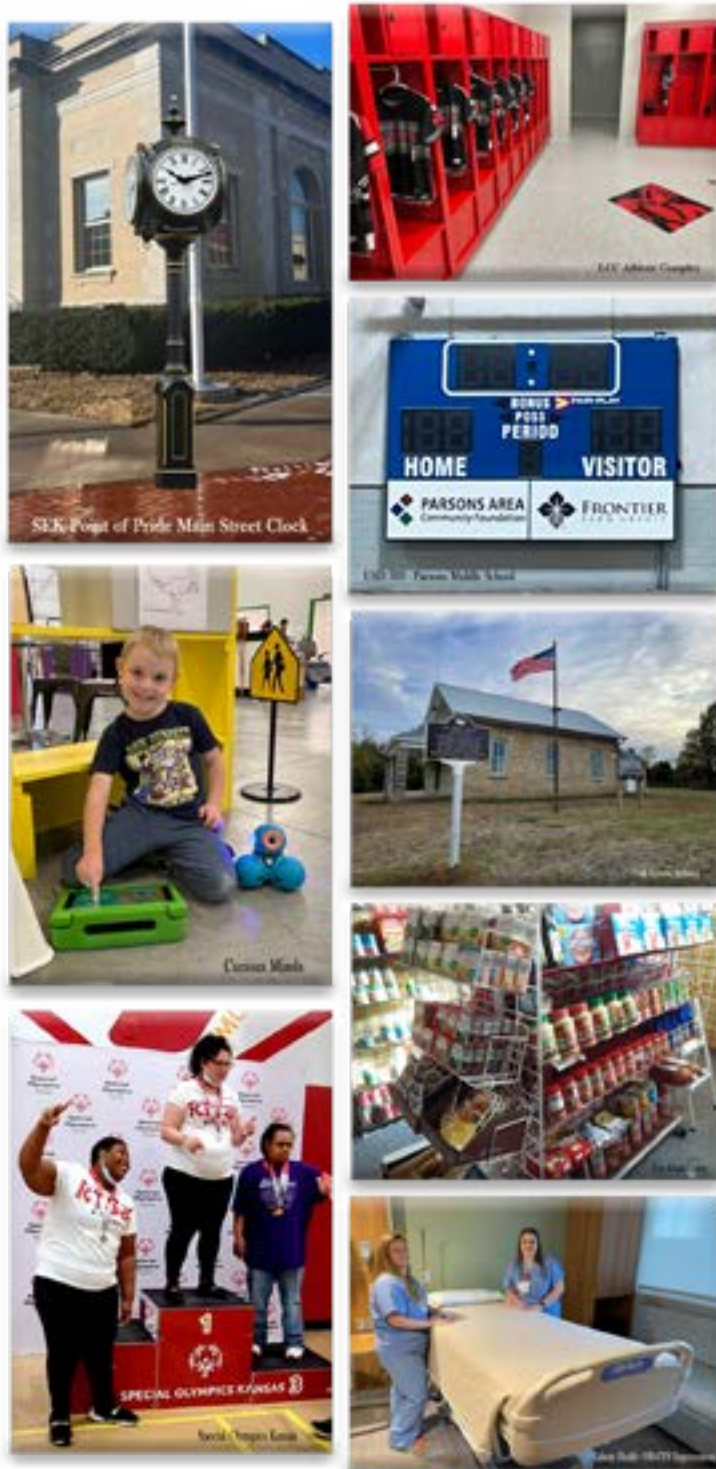

Field of Interest Funds

Some donors choose to establish funds for a specific field of interest such as helping those in need, the arts, education, city beautification, or community events. These funds are administered by the PACF board, aligning the stated field of interest with requests in that field.

Another option for donors are funds designated specifically for one or more organizations. Should that organization cease to exist, the fund will continue to give to another organization in the same field. If endowed, the organization has the option of taking an annual distribution or leaving it in the fund to build the endowment.

Agency Funds

It involves a contract between a donor and the community foundation with the donor transferring cash or property to the foundation in exchange for a partial tax deduction and a lifetime stream of annual income. When the donor passes, the community foundation receives the balance of the gift.
